It can be used towards travel and accommodation costs associated with travelling to Canberra to use the library. The \$2500 award is offered annually and generally to one person, but may be split between candidates at the selection committee's discretion.

Applications should be limited to three pages and include:

- curriculum vitae
- brief outline of the proposed project
- Basser Library collection/s to be consulted
- budget.
