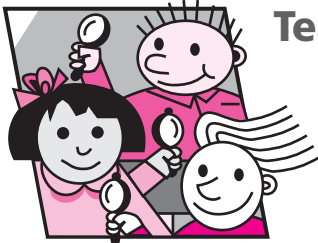


Changing pictures

Today, you can make moving pictures that show change.



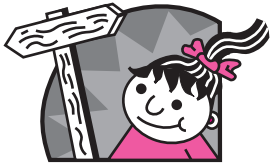
Team investigation

Make a picture theatre and a picture strip for everyone on your team.

What changes do your team's pictures show?

Team equipment

- 3 cardboard strips
- 3 picture strips
- coloured pencils
- 3 pairs of scissors
- sticky tape
- job badges for director, manager and speaker



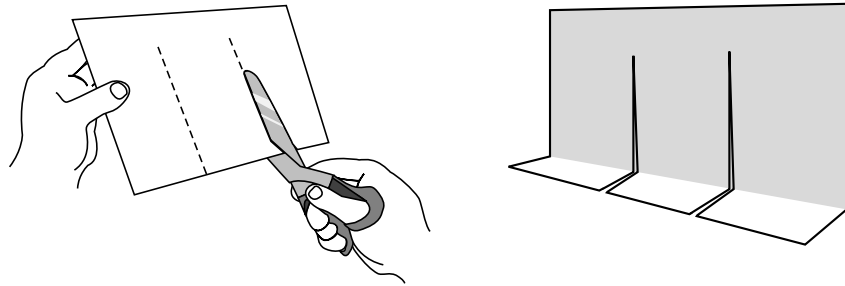
How to do it

Step 1

Cut two slits in the cardboard strips.

Step 2

Fold the bottom to make a stand.



Step 3

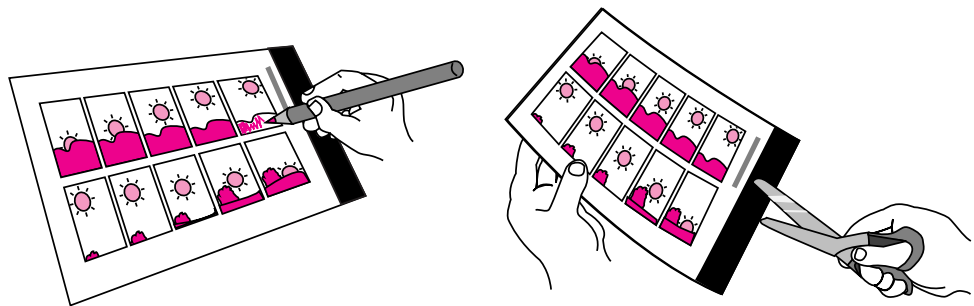
Colour in your picture strip.

Remember to use the same colours for each picture in the strip.

Step 4

Cut out each picture strip.

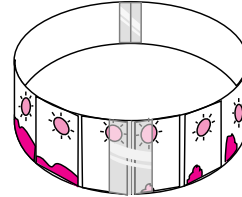
Cut the edges neatly so that the strip will turn easily in your picture theatre.



Step 5

Join the two strips with sticky tape at the back and the front to form a loop.

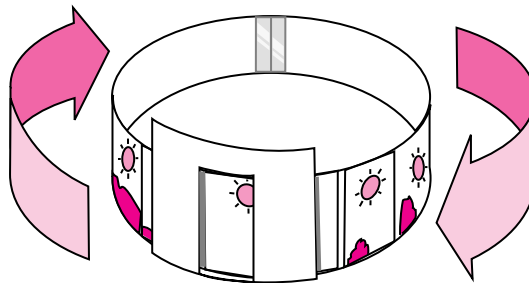
This is your picture strip.



Step 6

Slot the picture strip into the slits in the cardboard.

Turn the loop slowly to show the pictures.



Step 7

Show each picture to your team mates and tell them what happens in your picture strip.
