Phase	Lesson	At a glance
<b>ENGAGE</b>	<b>Lesson 1</b> Wondering about water	To capture students' interest and find out what they think they know about water, where it comes from and how to use it responsibly.  To elicit students' questions about water.
	<b>Lesson 2</b> Water walk	To provide hands-on, shared experiences of water use at school.
<b>EXPLORE</b>	<b>Lesson 3</b> Rain, rain  <b>Session 1</b> It's raining  <b>Session 2</b> Ground water	To provide hands-on, shared experiences of what happens to rain falling on different surfaces.
	<b>Lesson 4</b> Go with the flow	To support students to explore the movement of water across the landscape.
	<b>Lesson 5</b> My water story	To introduce current scientific views and support students to represent and explain their understanding about sources of water, and how it is collected, transported, accessed and used.
