



## The Foreign Secretary

**11a The Foreign Secretary** shall be responsible, subject to the direction of the Council, for the international relations of the Academy and for the conduct of the relevant correspondence.

The duties of the **Foreign Secretary (Sec C)** include overseeing the Academy's international programs and representing the Academy at international meetings.

The **Foreign Secretary**, working closely with the Academy's Director International Programs and Awards:

- maintains contact and attends relevant meetings with other academies of science, and bilateral and multilateral international organisations that promote scientific excellence and understanding;
- chairs the Academy Committee on international Matters which provides advice on the International Council for Science (ICSU), the InterAcademy Partnership (IAP) - the Global Network of Science Academies, including IAP – Science, IAP – Research and IAP - Health, the Association of Academies and Societies of Sciences in Asia (AASSA), and any other international relations of the Academy referred to it;
- maintains contact with representatives of relevant Government department and agencies in Australia and overseas, to promote the use of science as a foreign policy tool;
- liaises with representatives of Foreign Governments to promote awareness of Australian Science capabilities and support for bilateral cooperation;
- provides advice in relation to meetings (conferences, symposia and workshops) organized by the Academy to foster international scientific cooperation;
- oversees committees tasked with allocating funding for Australian researchers travelling overseas under the exchange programs and administered by the Academy;
