Australia in the Asian Century

Driven by science, the world in 2012 is changing fast. Since the beginning of the 21st century, global investment on R&D has almost doubled, speeding up the pace of change itself. A decade into the 'Asian Century', Australia increasingly seeks to improve its links with its Asian neighbours, while maintaining and strengthening links with North America and Europe.

In November 2011 you met with the President of the Australian Academy of Science, Professor Suzanne Cory AC, to discuss the Academy's recently released Position Paper *Australian science in a changing world: innovation requires global engagement.*http://www.science.org.au/reports/documents/Innovationrequiresglobalengagement.pdf. It provides a sound direction for maintaining links with international science and maximising economic and social benefits for the nation. We hope that is also offers useful information for the White Paper on Australia in the Asian Century.

Prof Cory indicated that she would provide a short list of Fellows of the Academy and other Australian researchers with strong links in Asian countries. This may assist in the work of your Task Force. (Please see attached.)

For your information, in recent interactions with the President of the Indonesian Academy of Sciences, Prof Sangkot Marzuki AM, he has indicated that Indonesia is interested in the science education programs of the Australian Academy of Science, *Primary Connections* and *Science by Doing*. Dr Bruce Alberts, President Obama's Special Science envoy to Indonesia, has also had discussions with us regarding the possibility of introducing these programs into Indonesia. Prof Marzuki and Dr Alberts have asked the Academy for assistance on this matter.

The Academy looks forward to the release of the White Paper and hopes that it will provide strong recommendations that will support efforts to maintain Australia's scientific engagement in the Asian Century.
