



Impact and engagement

- **research impact** is the contribution that research makes to economy, society and environment, beyond the contribution to academic research
- **research engagement** is the interaction between researchers and research end-users for the mutually beneficial exchange of knowledge, technologies and methods, and resources in a context of partnership and reciprocity
