NOTES FOR REFEREES

Applicants are responsible for sending this form, a copy of their application and information about the Program to a referee who agrees to provide the Australian Academy of Science with a referee report by 5pm (AEST) Saturday 30 April 2016.

Referees are asked to complete the Referee Report Form addressing the following points:

- 1. Is your field of research the same as the applicant's? Please explain.
- 2. Please discuss the scientific merit of the proposal.
- **3.** The objective of the Program is to support research and initiate or consolidate collaboration with a leading-edge French host organisation. Would the proposed visit achieve these outcomes (e.g. establish links with researchers; gain access to equipment, knowledge and/or skills not available in Australia)?
- **4.** Please describe the benefits of conducting this research project in France rather than in another country, including Australia.
- **5.** What personal qualities does the applicant have that would make him/her successful in establishing or expanding contacts in France?
- **6.** Would the proposed visit contribute to the development of the applicant's field of research and/or career?
- 7. Please declare your connections with the applicant in the area of joint-publications.

How to send the referee report:

- The referee report should be sent by **5pm** (AEST) **Saturday 30 April 2016**.
- The referee report should be submitted electronically to the applicant's institution for inclusion in the completed grant application to be submitted by the research/grants office or directly to the Academy.
